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





Many of our students lack credits, so staff strives to provide a strong credit recovery program to assist students to attain their completion goals. We place students at a local community college to explore career paths and earn credits toward graduation. Our students who are over 18 need additional support to complete their diploma, so improving the 5 year completer rate is another area of focus for our staff


## REGULAR ATTENDERS

Students who attended more than 90% of their enrolled school days.





Students earning a high school diploma or GED within five years. Cohort Includes students who were first-time ninth graders in 2018-19 finishing in 2022-23.




#### **State Goals**



#### ADVANCED COURSEWORK


